



Part-Time Cool Chefs Culinary Educator

Overview:

The Cornucopia Project is a nonprofit organization that delivers a continuum of “edible education” programs to children located in the southwestern region of New Hampshire that includes school garden programs, culinary and nutrition education, and agricultural experiences. The Cool Chefs program is currently seeking a part time qualified Culinary Educator for its kitchen-based afterschool program for grades 3-4. Using a healthy, whole-child approach, the Cool Chefs Culinary Educator has primary responsibility for delivering hands-on, kitchen-based, after school nutrition and cooking classes in accordance with established programming.

Responsibilities:

In collaboration with the Cool Chefs Program Coordinator, the Culinary Educator will:

- Review and enhance a previously developed culinary curriculum
- Instruct themed lessons in a 5-week program (1 class per week)
- Participate in weekly planning and assessment meetings with Program Coordinator
- Interface with participant guardians as necessary
- Submit a weekly debrief online summary for Program Coordinator

Experience and Characteristics:

- 2-4-year degree in dietetics, nutrition, culinary arts, culinary education, or related field
- A passionate and skilled dietitian, nutritionist, chef, or culinary educator with 2-3 years experience teaching children in a classroom or kitchen-setting
- Ability to lead and engage a diverse youth audience with different levels of comfort and ability in a kitchen environment
- Is organized, has good time management skills, and is resourceful
- Possesses a can-do attitude, is a solid problem-solver, is flexible, creative, and fun
- Enjoys working in a team environment, has good communication and active listening skills
- Understands and is an advocate for fresh, local, in-season food and the importance of sustainability as it relates to Cornucopia’s mission of “growing healthy kids, good food, and strong communities.”
